Gunwharf Quays – home to a lot of outlet shops

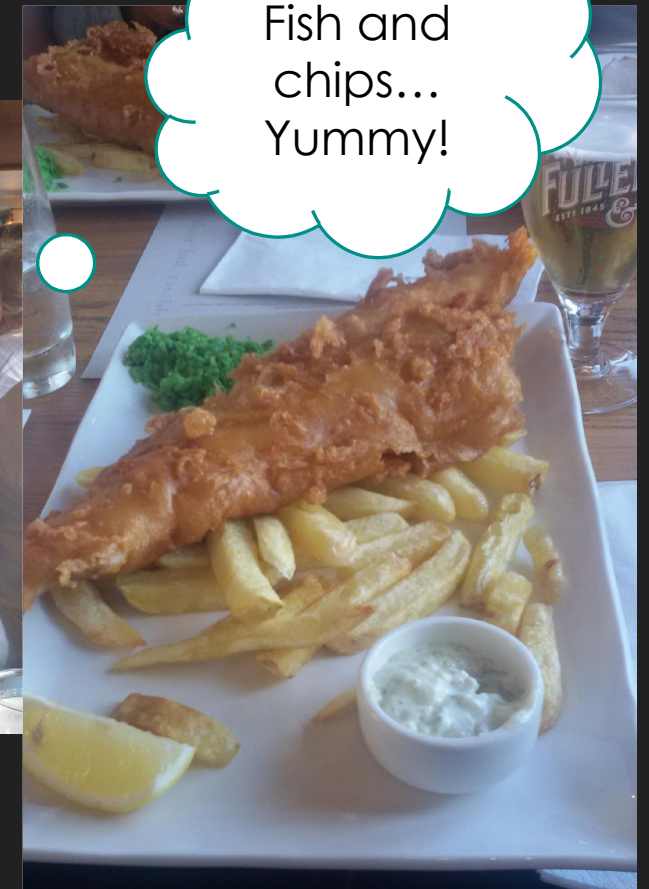

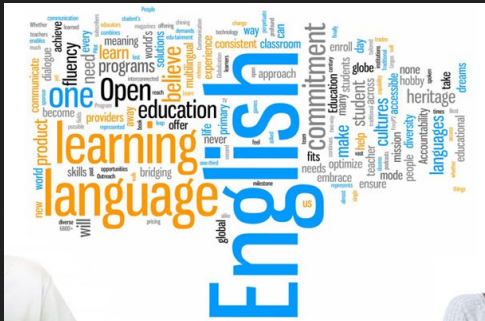
